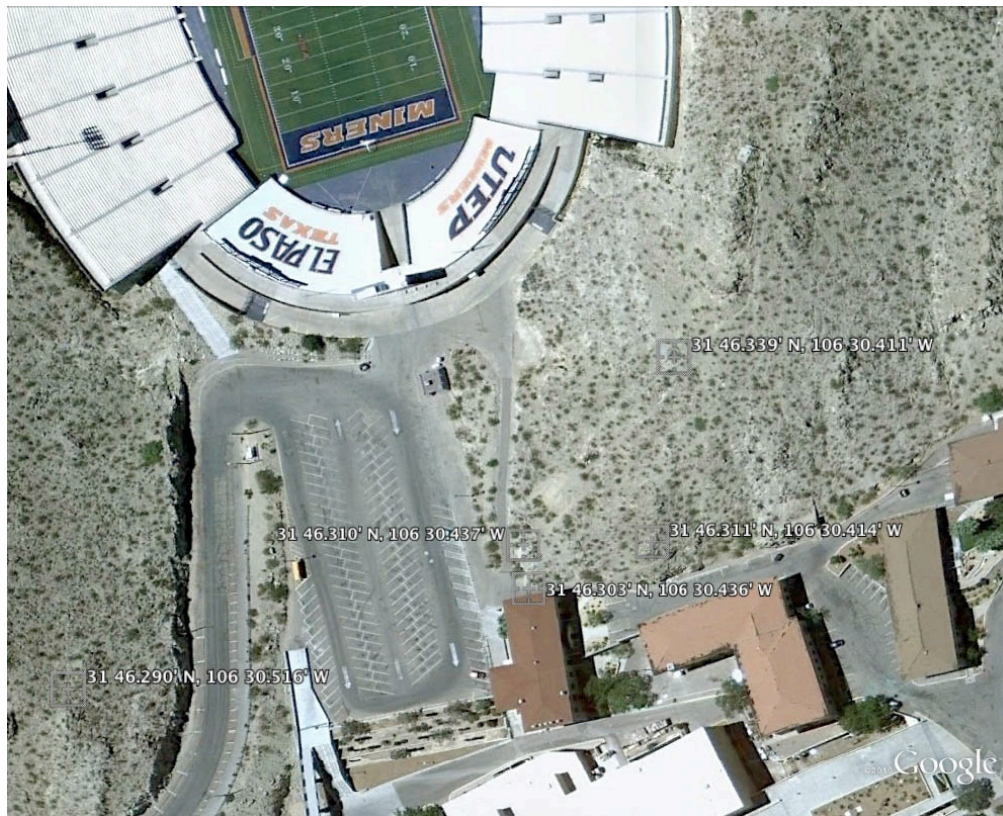

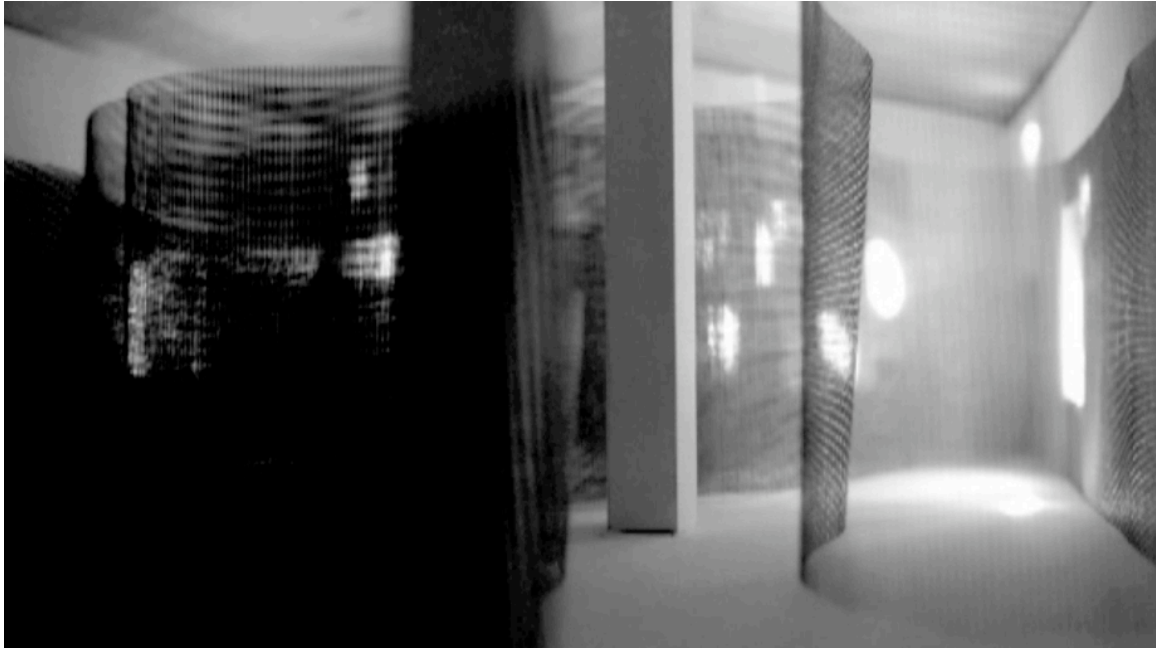

Light Lines: Jay Atherton and Cy Keener will transform the Ruben Gallery from an art exhibition space to a vessel of light. This architectural team will create sculpted walkways that will reflect and refract light from mirrors that are strategically placed at various locations on campus. By revealing several of the currently concealed windows in the Ruben Gallery, summer sunlight will be emitted and shaped during the exhibition. Atherton (b. 1976, South Korea) and Keener (b. 1975, Washington State) each earned a master's degree in architecture from the University of California Berkeley and are now principals at Atherton | Keener. Their home, which they co-designed, was featured on the cover of *Dwell* magazine in December 2010. Also in 2010 Atherton | Keener produced the exhibition *90 Days Over 100* at the Scottsdale Museum of Contemporary Art.



Atherton | Keener will strategically place the mirrors around the university to reflect light into the gallery.

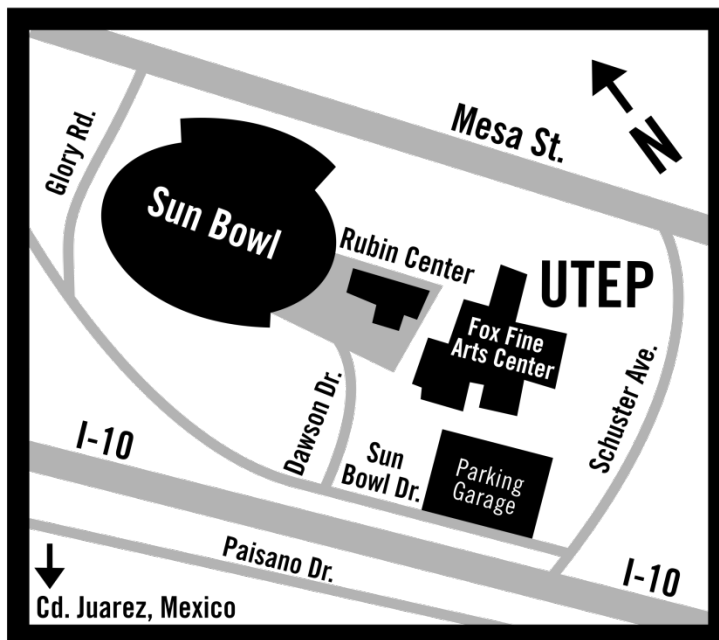
